ENTRY PROCEDURE:

Completed Team Entry Forms and fees are due at CRI Member Services **NO LATER THAN 6:00 PM on Thursday, May 20.** Entries MUST be submitted prior to the Captains' Meeting which will begin promptly at 6:00 PM. The entry fee must accompany the Entry Form in order for the team to be accepted. ***Registration may be limited.***

DIVISIONS & LEAGUES:

The divisions and leagues for Basketball are:

1. Men's
2. Women's

LOCATION OF PLAY:

All games will be played at the Recreation Activity Center Courts (RAC).

SCHEDULES:

Season schedules will be available on **Friday, May 21, by 4:00 PM** at CRI Member Services. Schedules will be posted on Intramural Sports bulletin boards in the RAC and on the CRI website at:

DAYS AND TIMES OF PLAY:

Games will be scheduled Mondays through Thursdays from 6:00 PM to 10:00 PM.
League play will begin on May 24.

ROSTERS:

1. Rosters are unlimited. Teams may carry as many members as they like. The number of participants required for Men's and Women's play is five.
2. **A participant may play on a maximum of one Men's/Women's team and one Co-Rec team in each sport.**
3. Each division will be divided into leagues based upon the number of teams entered and playing availability.
4. Roster additions are made when an individual is entered on a scoresheet and participates in a game. Roster additions may be made at the game site with the Intramural Supervisor or Scorekeeper. ***The deadline for adding players to a team's roster is the team's last game of the regular season.***

TOURNAMENT FORMAT:

1. Post-season tournaments will be held for Men's and Women's divisions.
2. The availability of time and facilities will determine the number of teams advancing to playoffs.

DEFAULTS & FORFEITS:

Teams that forfeit once (2 defaults=1 forfeit) will not be eligible for playoffs. A second forfeit will result in suspension of that team from further play.

ID CARDS:

A valid government-issued photo ID must be presented to be eligible to participate in any of the Campus Recreation and Intramural-sponsored activities. Acceptable forms of identification include a Georgia Southern University ID Card and a valid driver's license.

WAIVER RELEASE FORMS:

Each participant must read and sign a Waiver Release Form and receive a star on his/her ID card before participating in any CRI-sponsored activity.

ELIGIBILITY:

Eligible:

- All undergraduate and graduate students enrolled in **at least 4 on-campus hours for any Summer term or combined terms** or who have paid the appropriate RAC fees.
- All **full-time** faculty and staff members employed by any division of Georgia Southern University with a valid ID.
- Any student who is not enrolled for summer classes may become eligible to participate by paying the appropriate RAC summer activity fee at CRI Member Services.

Ineligible:

- **All** current GSU basketball players and red-shirts (2009-2010 academic year).

EQUIPMENT:

The following equipment is available for check-out with a current ID card from the RAC during operational hours and/or from the Intramural Staff at the game site.

- Basketballs
- Jerseys (at game site)

INTRAMURAL SPORTS WEATHERLINE:
