ENTRY PROCEDURE:

Completed Team Entry Forms and fees are due at CRI Member Services on **Tuesday, June 29 by 6:00 PM**. The entry fee must accompany the Entry Form in order for the team to be accepted.

Registration may be limited.

DIVISIONS & LEAGUES:

Each 4-person team will compete in one Open division, regardless of team members' genders.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT:

The format of the tournament will be a double-elimination tournament.

LOCATION OF PLAY:

All games will be played at the Recreation Activity Center (RAC) Sand Volleyball Courts.

SCHEDULES:

Tournament brackets will be available on **Thursday, July 1, by 2:00 PM** at CRI Member Services. Schedules will be posted on Intramural Sports bulletin boards in the RAC and on the CRI website at: www.georgiasouthern.edu/cri.

ROSTERS:

1. Rosters are unlimited. Teams may carry as many members as they like. The number of participants required for play is four.
2. **A participant may play on a maximum of one team in this sport.**
3. Roster additions are made when an individual is entered on a scoresheet and participates in a game. Roster additions may be made at the game site with the Intramural Supervisor or Scorekeeper. ***Team rosters will be frozen beginning with the semifinal round of play.***

ID CARDS:

A valid government-issued photo ID must be presented to be eligible to participate in any of the Campus Recreation and Intramural-sponsored activities. Acceptable forms of identification include a Georgia Southern University ID Card and a valid driver's license.

WAIVER RELEASE FORMS:

Each participant must read and sign a Waiver Release Form and receive a star on his/her ID card before participating in any CRI-sponsored activity.

ELIGIBILITY:

Eligible:

- All undergraduate and graduate students enrolled in **at least 4 on-campus hours for any Summer term or combined terms** or who have paid the appropriate RAC fees.
- All **full-time** faculty and staff members employed by any division of Georgia Southern University with a valid ID.
- Any student who is **not** enrolled for summer classes may become eligible to participate by paying the appropriate **RAC summer activity fee** at CRI Member Services.

Ineligible:

- All current GSU volleyball players and redshirts (2009-2010 academic year).

Note that a team is permitted no more than two (2) players on its roster who are current GSU Volleyball Club members.

EQUIPMENT:

The following equipment is available for check-out with a current ID card from the RAC during operational hours and/or from the Intramural Staff at the game site.
