SPORTS TRIVIA RULES
2009 – 2010

PLAYERS & EQUIPMENT

1. Each participant must present a current GSU student or faculty/staff ID card in order to be eligible to participate.
2. Each team shall consist of 4 players. Each team must have a minimum of 3 players in order to begin a game. Teams may consist of any combination of men and/or women. Rosters are limited to a maximum of 5 members. Team rosters are frozen following pool play. No roster additions may be made during the single-elimination playoffs.
3. All games will be played in the Recreation Activity Center (RAC) Seminar Room (2nd Floor) and the Conference Room (1st Floor).
4. Each player will have a hand-held buzzer provided by the staff on duty.

GAME FORMAT

1. Each game will consist of a series of 20 toss-up questions and associated bonus questions. Each game will have a time limit of 30 minutes.
2. A toss-up question worth 10 points will be directed to both teams. Any player may buzz in and answer the question. Teammates may not confer for a toss-up question.
3. Upon correctly answering a toss-up question, a team will gain control and receive a bonus question worth 30 points. Teammates may confer before answering a bonus question.
4. Teams will be given a certain amount of time (not to exceed 20 seconds and based on number of answers required per question) to confer and answer the question. The designated captain of the team will be asked to verbalize the answer for his/her team. No other answers will be considered, therefore teams may confer aloud.
5. After a team has successfully or unsuccessfully completed the bonus question, another toss up question will be asked to both teams. This will continue until all 20 questions have been asked or until time has expired.
6. The winner of the game will be the team that accumulates the most total points for correctly answered questions.
7. Toss Up Question Rules:
 - A. All players are eligible to answer any toss up question.
 - B. All toss up questions are worth 10 points.
 - C. If a player buzzes in before a question is completed, the question will not be finished and an answer must be given.
 - D. If a player buzzes in prior to a question being completed and answers the question incorrectly, the team will be penalized 5 points. The question will be completed and the opposing team will have an opportunity to answer.
 - E. If a player buzzes in upon completion of a question, no penalty will be given for an incorrect answer, and the opposing will be given a chance to buzz in and answer.
 - F. Only one player is eligible to answer a toss up question per team per question.
 - G. All toss up questions must be answered within 5 seconds.
8. Bonus Question Rules:
 - A. All bonus questions are worth 30 points.
 - B. Teamwork is allowed during bonus questions.
 - C. For bonus questions, only answers from the designated team captain that are directed at the questioner will be accepted.
 - D. Points will not be deducted for incorrect answers during bonus questions.
