**The College of Education (COE) moved into its new facilities in June 2000.**  
The 104,760 square foot building includes an office wing and a classroom wing.

The four-story **OFFICE BUILDING** houses all faculty and staff offices, work space for graduate assistants, the COE Advisement Center, the Publication Center, a 27 seat conference room, and smaller meeting rooms.

The three-story **CLASSROOM BUILDING** includes a 383 seat Lecture Hall with state-of-the-art technology capabilities, 38 classrooms including two science labs and a multimedia classroom, the Instructional Resources Center with its four computer labs, the Technology Education Laboratory, observation labs, and a multipurpose Community Room.

The offices of the University's **Distance Learning Center** and two distance learning classrooms are also located on the second floor of the classroom building.
