The College of Information Technology, now occupying a newly opened \$33 million complex, offers the region's most advanced education in digital applications and a new locus of high-tech opportunity in the University System.

First opened for classes summer 2003, this 142,000 square foot academic building includes a 240-seat auditorium, a 120-seat tiered lecture hall, 12 classrooms, 10 computer labs, and a number of faculty and administrative offices. The two-story, atrium-style lobby features a deli-style sandwich shop and a bookstore.

The College of Information Technology at Georgia Southern University became active July 1, 2003. The college consists of three academic departments, including: the Computer Sciences Department, the Information Systems Department, and the Information Technology Department.
